#### COMMENTS

- 1) didactics (optional class) – a class to be chosen from the list (an example list below);
- 2) optional monographic lectures for doctoral students help develop professional skills and prepare for research into philosophy (9 ECTS);
- 3) it is not possible to choose monographic lectures from a different level of studies, as they do not ensure proper accomplishment of the above-mentioned objectives;
- 4) at the beginning of the studies, students must submit to the Dean's Office a declaration of the duration of the modern foreign language course (year 1-2 or year 3-4), or a request to be exempt from the modern foreign language course on account of an appropriate certificate;
- 5) the number of practice teaching hours – whereby doctoral students run classes at university or participate in them – may not be less than 10 and more than 90 in the year (Journal of Laws 2013, item 841). Every year, practice teaching yields 1 ECTS credit point.

Proposed optional lectures that develop teaching skills and prepare students for the profession of a university teacher (3 lectures must be chosen; a total of 9 ECTS credit points):

1. Teaching philosophy
2. Art of argumentation
3. Art of interpretation
4. Multimedia and network technologies in the teaching of philosophy
